Until this time we were only allowed to come in to teach special classes in English and Moral Ethics.

Now we are able to come in and actually have an open worship service with those who accepted Christ and those interested. Before we dismiss we are able to break up into smaller groups in order to talk more individually to those who are ready to make decisions.

Please pray that we will continue to see progress in this great outreach. Already we have had several prisoners released and contact churches near their home that we have been able to connect them with.
